



Women's Sailing Champions League 2022 in Lausanne 06- 09 Oct 2022

The top event of the year in European women's sailing

Women's sailing teams from all over Europe will travel to Lake Geneva in Lausanne to compete for the Women's Champions League title. The race will be sailed on J/70s in the Umpired Fleet Race format.

The teams come from the following countries: Sweden, Norway, Finland, France, and Austria each have one team. Denmark, the Netherlands, and Poland will each start with two teams, Germany will come with five teams and Switzerland will start as host with eight teams. Each team consists of four or five sailors.

The host Cercle de la Voile de Vidy Lausanne will make its marina and beautiful clubhouse accessible for this top event in women's sailing in Europe.

The first day will be a training day on the water. The teams will be able to get acquainted with the local nautical conditions of Lake Geneva. In the evening, the teams will be introduced, and everyone can get to know each other and exchange ideas at a welcome aperitif.

On Friday, after the morning skippers' meeting, the first races will start. We hope for good sailing conditions for this. On this day there will be the first drone recordings of the streaming team. The evening will end with a pasta festival.

All races from Saturday and Sunday will be streamed live. Images from the drone, from the support boat, as well as from the various perspectives of the on-board cameras on the racing boats will be commented live by sailing professionals in English, German, and French. In this way, many sailing fans throughout Europe will be able to experience the excitement of the individual races and the enthusiasm of the female sailors.

The women of the sailing teams will have the opportunity to network with each other at a skipper dinner on Saturday and to build or deepen friendships.

On Sunday, the final day of racing, things will get busy again as the final races start in the afternoon to finally crown the winning women's team. This team will take part in the Sailing Champions League Finals of the best club teams in Europe.
